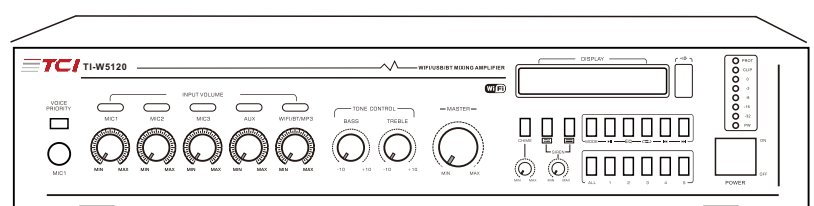

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- ※ Be sure to read the instructions in this section carefully before use.
- ※ Make sure to observe the instructions in this manual as the conventions of safety symbols and messages regarded as very important precautions are included.
- ※ We also recommend you keep this instruction manual handy for future reference.

WARNING

When Installing the Unit

- ※ Do not expose the unit to rain or an environment where it may be splashed by water or other liquids, as doing so may result in fire or electric shock.
- ※ Use the unit only with the voltage specified on the unit. Using a voltage higher than that which is specified may result in fire or electric shock.
- ※ Do not cut, kink, otherwise damage nor modify the power supply cord. In addition, avoid using the power cord in close proximity to heaters, and never place heavy objects -- including the unit itself -- on the power cord, as doing so may result in fire or electric shock.
- ※ Be sure to replace the unit's terminal cover after connection completion. Because high voltage is applied to the speaker terminals, never touch these terminals to avoid electric shock.
- ※ Be sure to ground to the safety ground (earth) terminal to avoid electric shock. Never ground to a gas pipe as a catastrophic disaster may result.
- ※ Avoid installing or mounting the unit in unstable locations, such as on a rickety table or a slanted surface. Doing so may result in the unit falling down, causing personal injury and/or property damage.

When the Unit is in Use

- ※ Should the following irregularity be found during use, immediately switch off the power, disconnect the power supply plug from the AC outlet and contact your nearest dealer. Make no further attempt to operate the unit in this condition as this may cause fire or electric shock.
 - If you detect smoke or a strange smell coming from the unit.
 - If water or any metallic object gets into the unit.
 - If the unit falls, or the unit case breaks.
 - If the power supply cord is damaged (exposure of the core, disconnection, etc.)
 - If it is malfunctioning (no tone sounds.)
- ※ To prevent a fire or electric shock, never open nor remove the unit case as there are high voltage components inside the unit. Refer all servicing to your nearest dealer.
- ※ Do not place cups, bowls, or other containers of liquid or metallic objects on top of the unit. If they accidentally spill into the unit, this may cause a fire or electric shock.
- ※ Do not insert nor drop metallic objects or flammable materials in the ventilation slots of the unit's cover, as this may result in fire or electric shock.

CAUTION**When Installing the Unit**

- ※ Never plug in nor remove the power supply plug with wet hands, as doing so may cause electric shock.
- ※ When unplugging the power supply cord, be sure to grasp the power supply plug; never pull on the cord itself. Operating the unit with a damaged power supply cord may cause a fire or electric shock.
- ※ When moving the unit, be sure to remove its power supply cord from the wall outlet.

When the Unit is in Use

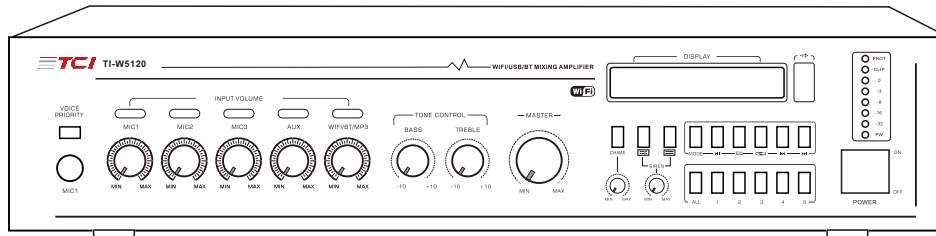

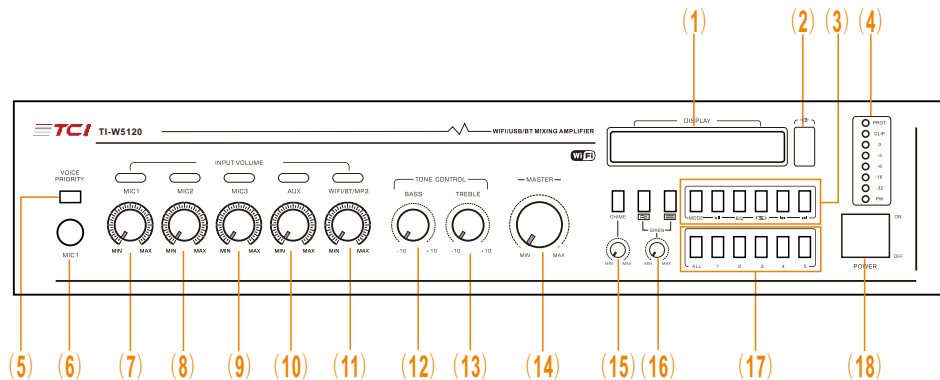
The WIFI/USB/BT Mixing Amplifiers are designed to meet the requirements of medium sized professional public address installations, and designed with overall 70/100-volt and 4/8 ohms(Ω) loads and featured an industry leading 5 zoned 100 volt load solution, 120/240/350 watts of amplifier power are available, with provided an audio output to 5 different zones within the venue, each zone has its own separate switch on/off manually operated on front panel.

Its outstanding feature of WiFi wireless music streaming receiver, supports connection with your smart device via a free APP, one RJ45 port is available on the rear panel as a backup for the point where the WiFi signal is weaker. Three microphone jacks support 48V Phantom Power microphone and 6.35mm plug microphone, pushing the button "VOICE PRIORITY" the MIC1 can be set with priority over the other inputs.

All units feature protections against operation under quite severe misuse such as over temperature, over voltage, over load and short circuit speaker line conditions.

FRONT PANEL



(1) SCREEN: Displays the working status of playing programmes.

(2) USB INPUT INTERFACE: Allows you to play USB disk.

(3) MP3 CONTROLLERS:

MODE To select the mode among WiFi, USB and bluetooth.

▶|| This button play or pause USB/BT song.

■ This EQ mode button to create 6 different equalizer effects for USB songstop.

⏮ To press this button to play the USB songs repetitively for one or all.

⏪ This button shall return to the previous USB/BT song. Or keep pressing to reduce the volume.

⏩ This button shall skip to the next USB/BT song. Or keep pressing to increase the volume.

(4) LED INDICATORS:

PW Lights red when the amplifier is powered on.

-32/-16/-8/-3/0 Flashes according to the audio level.

CLIP Lights yellow when amplifier is overdriven.

PROT Lights red in the case of protection.

(5) VOICE PRIORITY: To press this button to provide Auto-Mute function for MIC 1.

(6) MIC1: 6.35mm microphone input jack.

(7) MIC1: Allows you to control the volume of MIC1 input.

(8) MIC2: Allows you to control the volume of MIC2 input.

(9) MIC3: Allows you to control the volume of MIC3 input.

(10) AUX: Allows you to control the volume of AUX input.

(11) MP3/BT/WIFI: Allows you to control the volume of USB, bluetooth or WiFi input.

(12) BASS: Controls the bass tone of the amplifier output.

(13) TREBLE: Controls the treble tone of the amplifier output.

(14) MASTER: The master volume control to collectively control the sound level of all outputs.

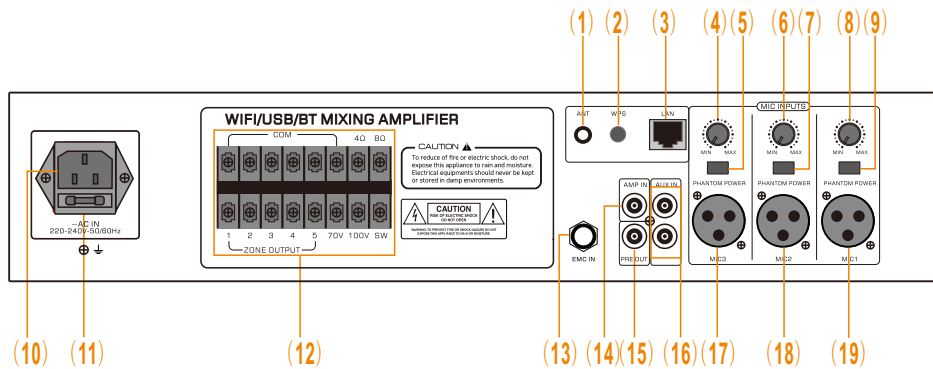
(15) CHIME: Chime tone activator and its volume control.

(16) SIREN: Two siren tone activators and volume control.

(17) ZONE CONTROLLERS

(18) POWER: Power switch ON/OFF.

REAR PANEL



- (1) **BT/WIFI ANTENNA JACK**: Using a special antenna allows for long-distance connection.
- (2) **WPS BUTTON**: Pressing it for 6–8 seconds then it will restart to its original factory state.
- (3) **LAN PORT**: Allows you to use network cable for the connection when the WiFi signal is weaker.
- (4) **MIC3 VOLUME CONTROL**: Allows you to control the volume of MIC3 on the rear.
- (5) **MIC3 PHANTOM POWER SWITCH**: Push to switch on or off the MIC3 48V Phantom Power.
- (6) **MIC2 VOLUME CONTROL**: Allows you to control the volume of MIC2 on the rear.
- (7) **MIC2 PHANTOM POWER SWITCH**: Push to switch on or off the MIC2 48V Phantom Power.
- (8) **MIC1 VOLUME CONTROL**: Allows you to control the volume of MIC1 on the rear.
- (9) **MIC1 PHANTOM POWER SWITCH**: Push to switch on or off the MIC1 48V Phantom Power.
- (10) **AC POWER INLET**: It accepts a standard 3-pin cable.
- (11) **AC FUSE DRAWER**: Contains one main fuse and one spare fuse.
- (12) **SPEAKER OUTPUT TERMINALS**: Please refer to its connection details on page 9 to 10.
- (13) **EMC Input Connector**: This connector allows to receive the EMC/ alarm signal overriding the other inputs.
- (14) **AMP IN**: It receives the signal from PER OUT of previous amplifier.
- (15) **PRE OUT**: It sends signal to AMP IN of next amplifier.
- (16) **AUX INPUT**: It accepts stereo “L” & “R” RCA connection, then converted to mono mode internally.
- (17) **MIC3 JACK**: It accepts balanced XLR connection and unbalanced 6.35mm connection.
- (18) **MIC2 JACK**: It accepts balanced XLR connection and unbalanced 6.35mm connection.
- (19) **MIC1 JACK**: It accepts balanced XLR connection and unbalanced 6.35mm connection.

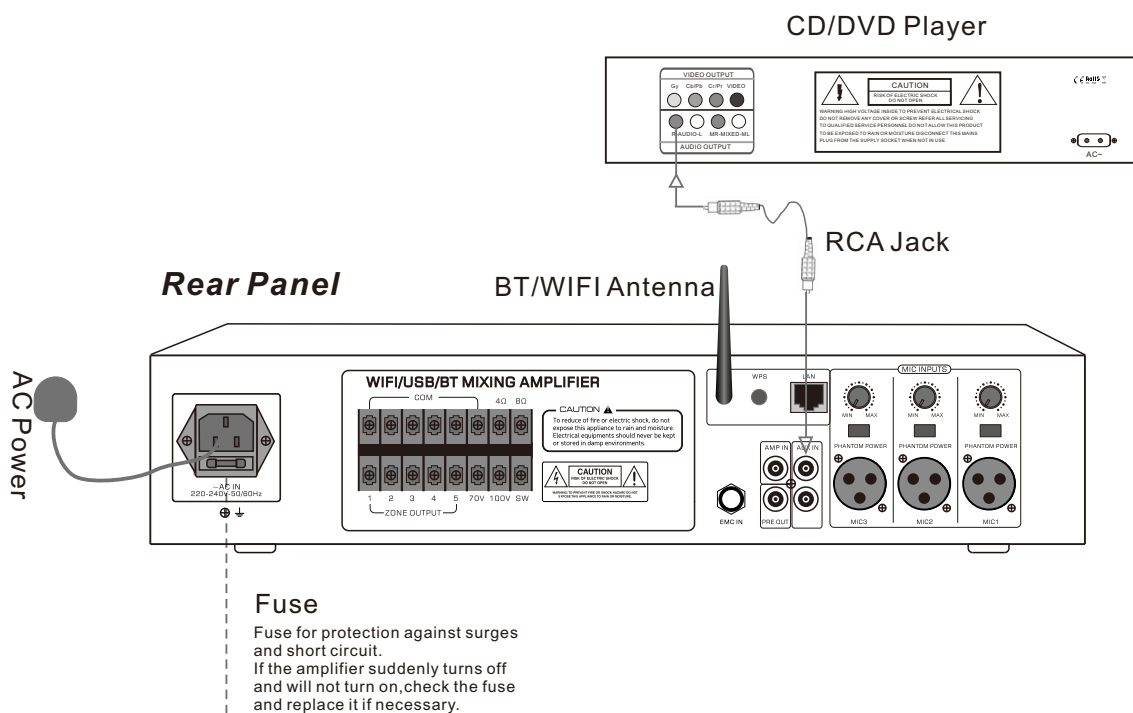
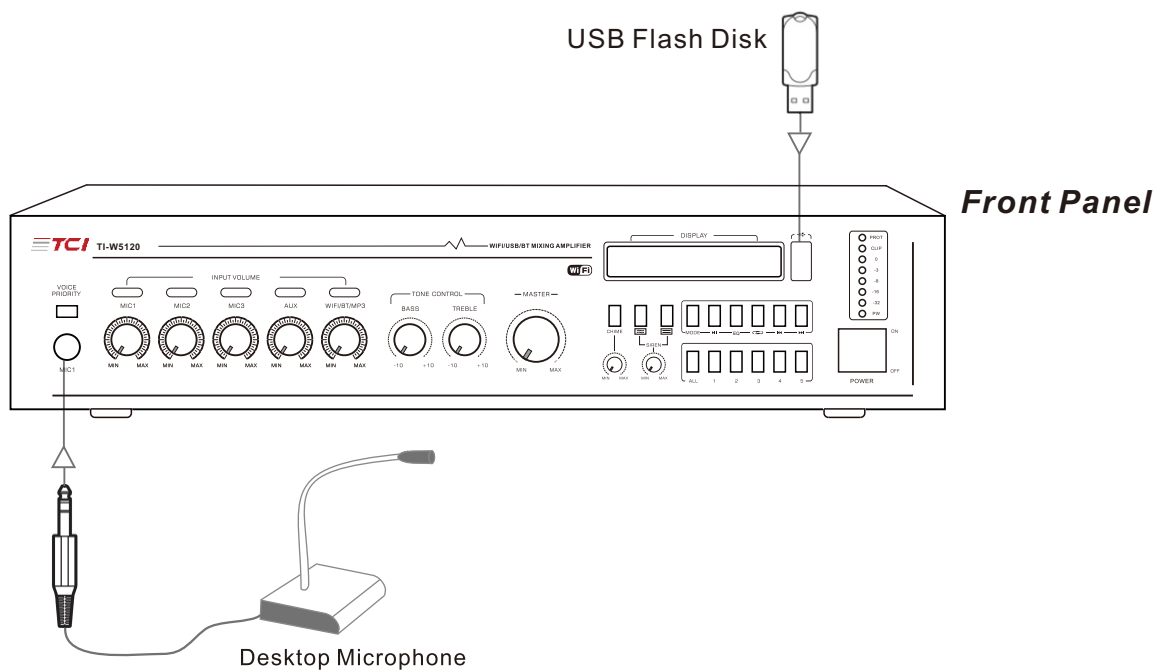

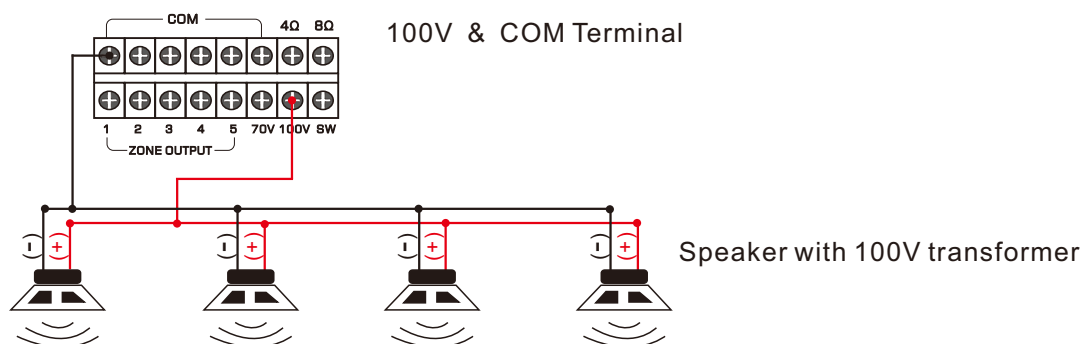
SPEAKER CONNECTION

Important Notes:

This amplifier has different loudspeakers outputs of 100V, 70V and low impedance 4Ω/8Ω. **It's only possible to use one output at the same time, connecting more than one may damage internal parts of the amplifier.** Each of 100V, 70V, 4Ω and 8Ω terminals must work with COM. (common) terminal.

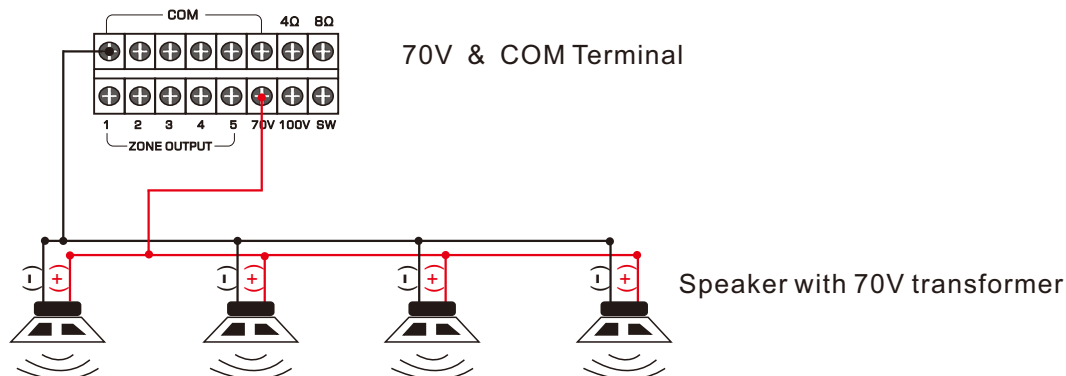
100V line output

This system is most commonly used in for PA system. Only use 100 V line loudspeakers with transformers. All loudspeakers are wired in parallel and the sum of their power must not exceed the rated output power of the amplifier. **It is advisable not to load the amplifier at more than 70% of its rated output power when using music sources.**



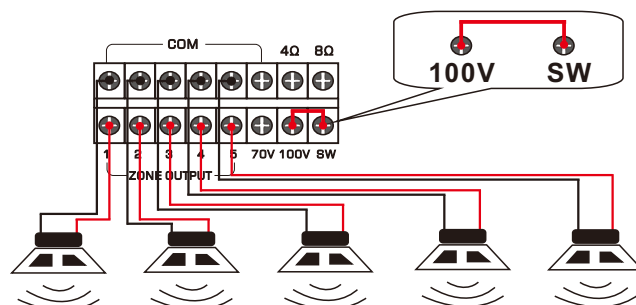
70V line output

This system is common in the USA, it operates on the same principles as 100 V line except that at rated output power the amplifier has 70V RMS on its output terminals.



5 zone outputs

If the 5 zone speaker outputs are going to be used based on 100V, the terminal "100V" & "SW" have to be connected together using a cable, 70V shares the same principles as 100V.



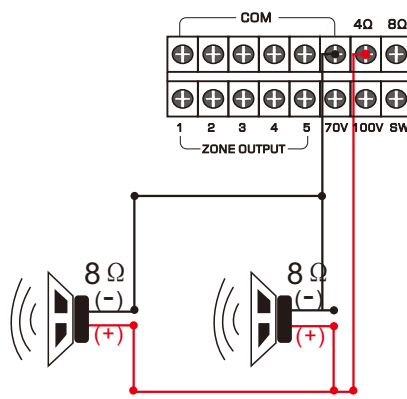
4Ω & 8Ω low impedance output

This output allows connection of low impedance loudspeakers without transformers,

When two or more loudspeakers are used ensure that they are wired in

such a way in Series, or in Parallel, or in Series & Parallel Combination that total load impedance remains at 4Ω or 8Ω.

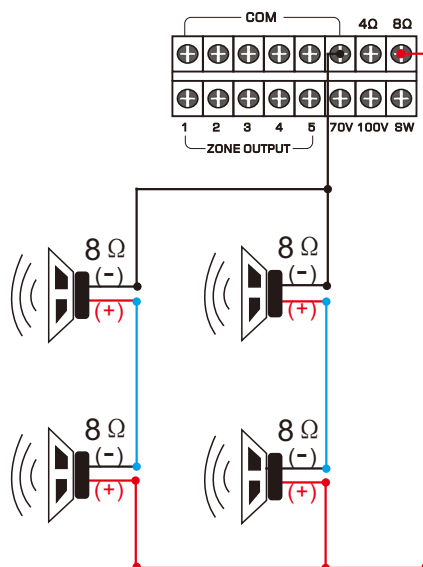
A. Connecting speakers in Parallel.

$$\frac{8\Omega \times 2}{2} = 8\Omega \text{ (Total load impedance)}$$

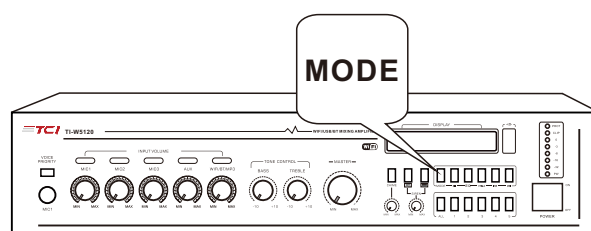
BLUETOOTH OPERATIONS

*Note: The Bluetooth name of this amplifier is “**BGM SYSTEM**”

In order to enjoy music from a Bluetooth device on this amplifier, the Bluetooth device must first be paired with this amplifier.

Once the Bluetooth device has been paired, it does not need to be paired again.

1. Press the MODE button on the front panel of the amplifier to switch the input source to “Bluetooth”.



2. Activate the Bluetooth settings on your mobile device.



3. Select this unit “**BGM SYSTEM**” when its name appears in the list of devices displayed on the screen of your mobile device.

Perform the connection with your mobile device close to the unit (about 1 m).

At the end of the pairing, the name “BGM SYSTEM” appears on the paired list of your mobile device.

4. Play music using any app on your mobile device.

* The next time the input source is switched to Bluetooth, this amplifier automatically connects to the last Bluetooth device that was connected.



WIFI & APP OPERATIONS



This amplifier uses the public Legacy Wireless Hi-Fi System

The amplifier's factory default Service Set Identifier(SSID) is: ex. "Link Play_XXXX"

GETTING STARTED

Connect the amplifier with your speakers.

TURNING ON THE WIFI AMPLIFIER

To turn this unit ON, plug in the power cord. When the unit turns on, the indicator light will flash Red. In order to connect this device to your Wi-Fi, you need to know your network credentials.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

This device is compatible with iPhone, iPod Touch and iPad devices running on iOS 6.0 or later and Android 2.3.3 or later.

NETWORK REQUIREMENTS

To access music services, Internet radio, and any digital music stored on your smart device or DLNA enabled Network-Attached Storage (NAS) device, your network must meet the following requirements:

NOTE: If you want to stream music through built-in App features such as Spotify, you will need to have a high speed internet connection. (Playback experience may differ depending on your internet connection speed.)

- If you are going to use the Legacy Player App on Android or iOS devices, a Wi-Fi Network will be required.
- You need to have your Wi-Fi network SSID and password.
- Your network configuration should not be in isolation mode.

CONNECT YOUR WIFI AMPLIFIER TO YOUR NETWORK VIA Legacy Player APP.


- Install the **Legacy Player App**  to your Smartphone or Tablet.
- Ensure that your Smartphone is connected to the same network that you are going to connect your Wi-Fi to.
- Open your WLAN settings to connect the amplifier's SSID "**Link Play_XXXX**" and you will see the

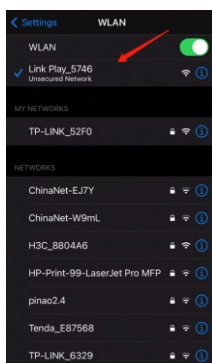

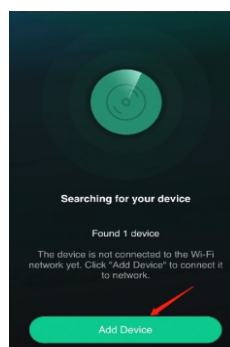

- Select your Wi-Fi SSID then '**Continue**' you will see the **Figure 4**.
- Input your Wi-Fi SSID password, then '**Continue**', when connected successfully you will see the **Figure 5**. Select '**Continue**', a pop up menu **Figure 6** will come up and you can select the name from pre-defined names or write a desired name for your unit. This will help you to easily differentiate units from one other on different locations (You cannot have two units with same name in the Legacy Player App).
- As the **Figure 6** shows, press the "**Next**" to enter the DEVICE LIST as the **Figure 7**,

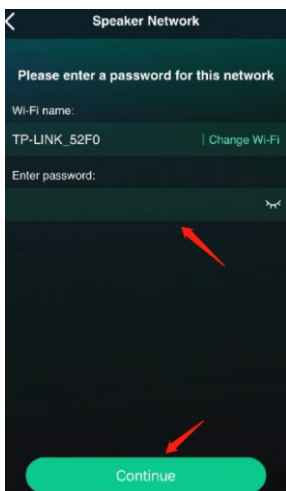

INSTRUCTIONS OF PLAYING MUSIC**My Music**

Through 'My Music', you can access the music that you have saved on your iOS or Android device's internal storage. You can also access music stored in music server. There are other options such as "recently played" and user created playlists etc.

In iOS, only music sync from your iTunes are accessible by the Legacy player. It is grouped by artists, album, playlists, or track. In each category, it is in alphabetical order. On Android device, all the music in the device is accessible, and it can be grouped by folder too.

**Spotify**

You can control music play through your Spotify app. Go to the Connect screen and select your Amplifier. For example, 'Family Room' Once you connect, you can stream Spotify to any room connected with a WiFi amplifier.

In order to use Spotify on your WiFi amplifiers you need to install Spotify on your connected Smartphone or Tablet. Go to the App Store or the Play Store and search for the Spotify App. Install the App and login into your account. If you do not have an account you will need to set one up.

**iHeartRadio**

iHeartRadio allows you to stream radio stations to your WiFi amplifier. Enter the menu and select 'iHeartRadio'. Select 'Genre' to choose the genre of radio you would like to listen to or select 'Country' and then the 'Region' to select localized radio stations.

**QINGTINGFM**

Enjoy live radio, news, music, fiction, comic, and podcast radio service.

NOTE: Currently only available on iOS.

**AirPlay**

You can play music through AirPlay on your iOS device. To do this you need to ensure that your iOS device and the WiFi amplifiers are connected to the same Wi-Fi network. Swipe up from the bottom of your iOS device and select 'AirPlay'. Select your WiFi amplifier and start playing your music.

NOTE: On multi-channel mode when you have two or more WiFi amplifier together, selecting AirPlay will play the selected music on all the amplifiers. Ensure that you increase the volume on the unit when listening to music on AirPlay.

**TIDAL**

TIDAL is the perfect match for the WiFi amplifier, streaming music in lossless, high fidelity audio quality, ensuring the best sound experience possible. Add high definition music videos, curated editorials by music journalists, artists and experts, and so much more.

NOTE: Currently only available on iOS.

**TuneIn**

TuneIn allows you to stream different channels of music and streaming talk radio. Enter the menu and select 'TuneIn'. Afterwards you will be prompted to localize or select a genre of music to begin playing.

**TTPOD**

TuneIn allows you to stream different channels of music and streaming talk radio. Enter the menu and select 'TuneIn'. Afterwards you will be prompted to localize or select a genre of music to begin playing.

**QQMusic**

With millions of tracks on QQMusic, the right music is always at your fingertips whether you're working out, playing or relaxing. Diversified ways are here to discover music you will love. The latest hits, the artists or DJs you like, intelligent recommendation based on your listening history, your next favorite songs are waiting for you.

NOTE: Currently only available on iOS.

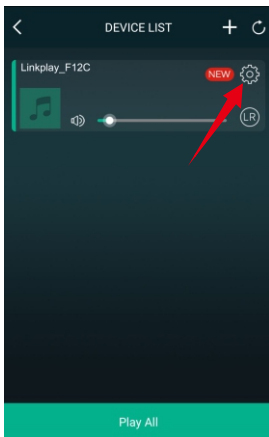
CHECK WI-FI STRENGTH

To achieve smooth streaming experience, your WIFI AMPLIFIER should have good network connection with your connected router. When connected with Wi-Fi, please check the Wi-Fi strength when you have problem with streaming experience. The steps to check the Wi-Fi strength are as follows:

1. Enter the **DEVICE LIST** menu.
2. Select the gear '⚙️' icon on the WiFi speaker you want to check, then you will see the **Figure 13**.
3. Select "**Speaker Info**" to see if your Wi-Fi connection is good enough as the **Figure 14**.

AMPLIFIER WI-FI PASSWORD PROTECTION

If you don't want the amplifier to be public, you can encrypt it by enabling "**Add Password Protection**",

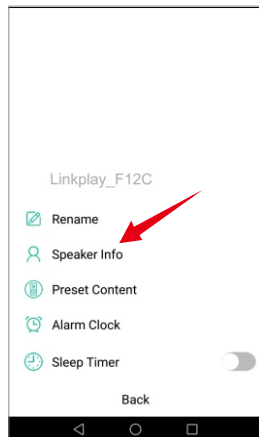

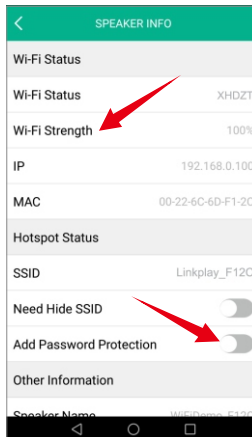

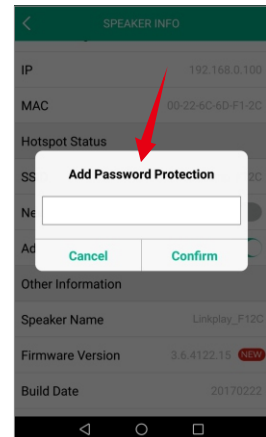

FACTORY RESET (Figure 16)

If you want to restore factory settings, select the "**Restore Factory Settings**" at the bottom of SPEAKER INFO menu to confirm.

FIRMWARE UPDATE (Figure 17)

If you see a "**New**" icon next to the setting button, it means a new firmware is available for your unit. In order to apply this firmware, tap on "New" and you will see a pop up message. Select upgrade and wait until the device upgrade process finishes.

NOTE: Do not conduct any other operation via the phone or the speaker unit while the firmware update is in progress.

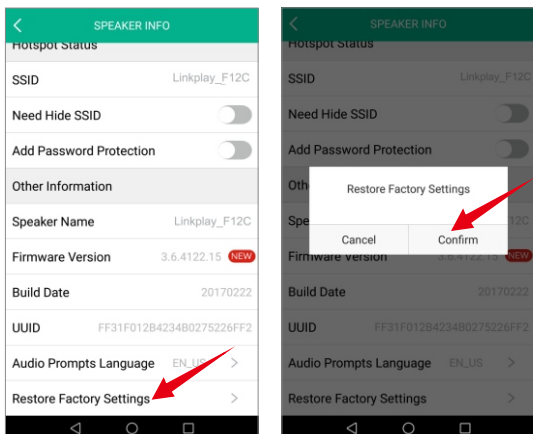

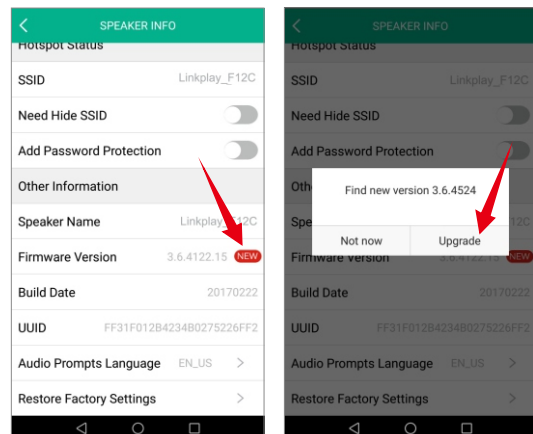

ALARM CLOCK (Figure 18)

You can set a timer on your device and set a sleep timer for it to turn off.

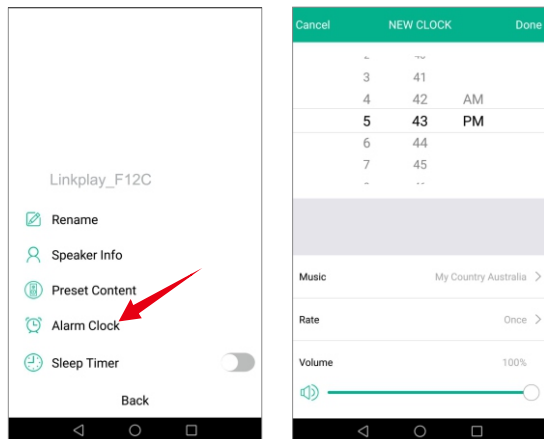

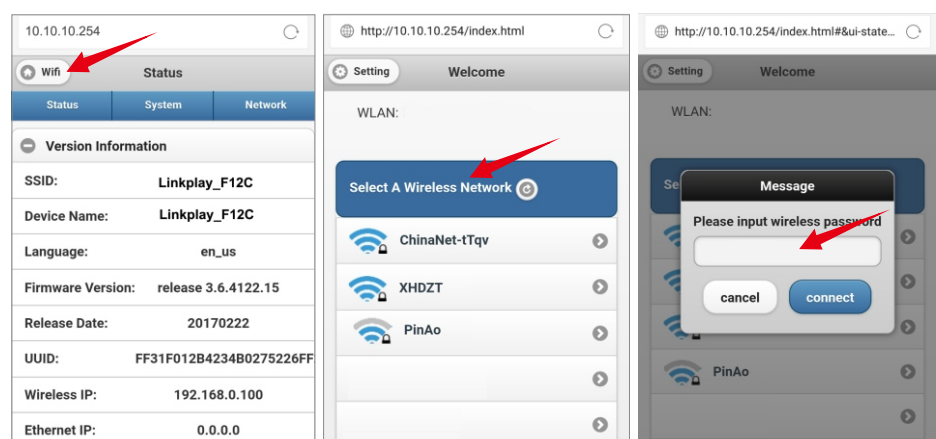
WEB BASED WI-FI SETUP

CONNECT AMPLIFIER TO WI-FI NETWORK (Figure 20)

- Open the **Wi-Fi Discovery Menu** on your Smartphone or Tablet and look for the Amplifier Service Set Identifier (SSID), ex. "Linkplay_XXXX".
- Select to connect your device to the Amplifier hotspot network
- Open a web browser on your Smartphone or Tablet and input '10.10.10.254' into the URL bar. This will lead you to the Wi-Fi setup page.
- Select your network from the list of available networks and input your home Wi-Fi password.
- Your device will disconnect from the Amplifier hotspot network and the amplifier will then connect to your Wi-Fi network.
- Your device will say "Connected" to indicate that your Amplifier has successfully connected to your Wi-Fi network.

You can click the “**System**” tab to select the language you want, then save it.

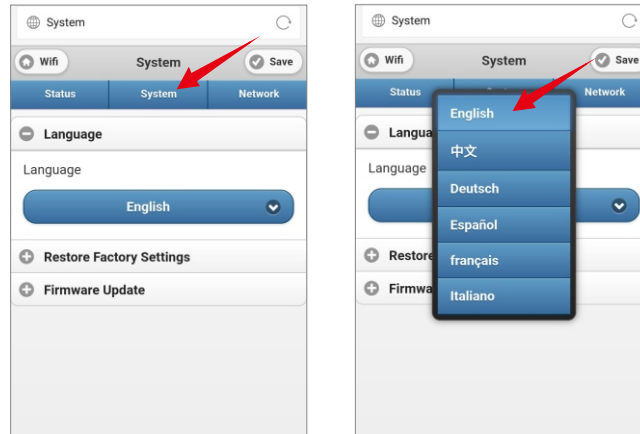

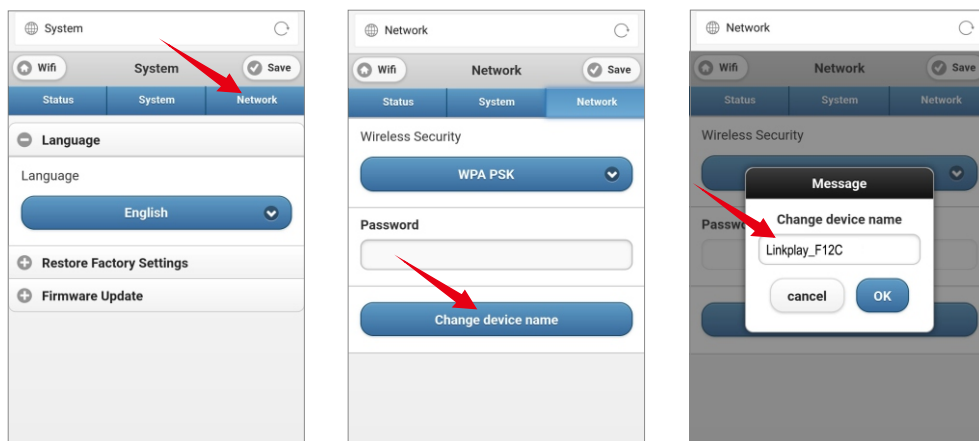

TROUBLESHOOT**SETTING UP THE AMPLIFIER****How do I connect the WIFI AMPLIFIER to my Wi-Fi network?**

You'll need to download the Legacy Player app for iOS or Android. Once you download it, the app will help you through the setup process.

I'm still having trouble setting up the Wi-Fi connection for my Amplifier. How can I fix the problem?

Try the following steps as an alternate way to set up your Wi-Fi connection:

1. Connect your phone or PC with your WIFI AMPLIFIER directly by finding the SSID (Format: Linkplay_XXXX) in your Wi-Fi setting.
2. Launch an internet browser in your device and enter <http://10.10.10.254>
3. Click the Wi-Fi button in the top left corner of the page, and select the router that you want to connect to. Enter the password to connect.

How do I initiate a factory reset? Here are two ways you can reset the WIFI AMPLIFIER:**Method 1:**

Locate the WPS button on the unit and press it for 6-8 seconds and then it will restart to its original factory state.

Method 2:

1. Find the unit you want to reset in the app.
2. Go to the Setting button and find "Speaker Info" and click "Restore Factory Settings".

How do I check if my WIFI AMPLIFIER firmware is up to date?

Please first refresh your "Device List" page. After you refresh, the app will prompt you to download firmware updates for any of your amplifier that do not have the latest firmware version. If this does not work for any reason, you can take the following steps to manually determine your firmware version and/or update your firmware:

1. Connect your computer or smartphone to the Amplifier Wi-Fi hotspot directly. Go to your device's wireless connection and select the Amplifier Wi-Fi SSID (the name format is "LinkPlay_XXXX").
2. Launch a web browser and enter <http://10.10.10.254> in the address bar.
3. To make sure you have the latest version, click the "System" tab and click on "Online Update". Update the firmware if needed and keep connection to Amplifier until firmware is complete.
4. Under the Status tab you can see the current firmware version number.

Will I be able to listen to Apple Music through the Amplifier from my iPhone, iPad, or Macbook Pro?

Yes.

How do I stream music from my DLNA enabled NAS (Network-Attached Storage) device?

First make sure your DLNA enabled NAS device is powered on and connected to the same wireless network as your Amplifier and smartphone/tablet. Tap the Legacy icon in the top left of the Legacy app. Select My Music, and select your device. You can then select music to stream from the DLNA enabled NAS device to your Amplifier. If you have any issues streaming music from your device, please check that your firmware is up to date.

Can I use my phone while playing music?

Yes, you can. Once your Amplifier is connected to your music, you can answer calls, make phone calls, turn off your phone and the speakers connected to your Amplifier will continue to stream music.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**Can I stream music from my Mac or PC?**

Yes, you can stream from Mac or PC using iTunes Airplay.

On PCs you can also stream from Windows Media Player to your Amplifier via a UPnP or DLNA certified controller, such as Play To. Just make sure your device and Amplifier are all on the same wifi network.

Please follow these steps:

1. Open Windows Media Player
2. In the play list, Click Play To and select the Amplifier device

Or

1. Right click on the song and Click Play To
2. Music starts streaming.

If the Amplifier device is not visible on the Media Player, go to Stream > More streaming options, and make sure the Amplifier is in Allowed state.

Why can't I see a music service in my Legacy App even though its listed as a supported music service?

Your firmware may be out of date. In the Legacy app, if you refresh your device list page, it will automatically prompt you to download the latest firmware update.

Can I login multiple WIFI AMPLIFIERS to Spotify at the same time?

You should be able to login multiple devices to your Spotify premium account but you can only stream Spotify from one device (or multi-room group) at a time. The Spotify App allows you to switch among different Spotify Connect clients. If you group multiple Amplifiers you'll only see the group master amplifier on the Spotify App.

What's the maximum number of Amplifier that can stream music on the same wireless network?

For this current version of the Amplifier you can have at most 6 in order to ensure a stable Wi-Fi connection. In future versions we are planning to allow more devices on the same Wi-Fi network, so appreciate your patience as we work on that!

Do the WIFI AMPLIFIER need to be on the same firmware version to stay in sync with one another?

Yes! Please keep the firmware in sync since we are still optimizing certain features that require the latest firmware.
